



### VIBE STUDIOS CONCERT & PERFORMANCE ETIQUETTE!

#### **GENERAL**

- Ⓢ Be sure to mark all concert, dress rehearsal, photo day, cheerleading matches and competition dates in your diary as soon as you are told. All events are compulsory and plenty of warning must be given if you are unable to attend.
- Ⓢ Competition team members must wear a Vibe Jacket to and from all performances.
- Ⓢ Strictly NO Smoking, Drinking or Drugs are allowed at any Vibe event.

#### **COSTUMES**

- Ⓢ Full hair, make-up and costumes must be worn at Dress Rehearsals, Photo Days, Performances and Concerts
- Ⓢ Travel to and from events in your own clothes. Once at the venue, you may change into your costume.
- Ⓢ At concerts students are not to wear their costumes in the audience, foyer area or anywhere you may be visible to audience members when not on stage.
- Ⓢ At the end of the second performance of both the Mid Year and End of Year concerts, costumes must be returned and students' name marked off the list. Costumes that fail to be returned will result in a \$50 fee.
- Ⓢ Once costumes are given out they are your responsibility. If any part of the costume is lost or damaged the parent/guardian/student must replace or pay for it.
- Ⓢ Dancers must not eat or drink in their costumes! The only exception is water.
- Ⓢ All term and costume hire fees must be paid in full before costumes are given to students.

#### **CONCERTS**

- Ⓢ Parents of Kinder dance and Pre Primary students are allowed in change rooms, but not side of stage.
- Ⓢ There will be 1 parent assigned per class for Junior, Sub-Inter and Inter groups to help with costume changes. No other parents or friends are allowed in change rooms or side of stage. No exceptions!
- Ⓢ Please remember to be on your best behavior! Seniors, you are role models for the younger students and all students are representatives of Vibe Studios. Be aware of your language and manners!
- Ⓢ At concerts, students may only stand side stage if they are about to go on. No watching from side stage is allowed! You must remain in the change room area until your group is called.
- Ⓢ Toilets are not change rooms! Please keep the toilet free for those who need it and change in the change rooms provided to you.
- Ⓢ When approaching anywhere near the stage area, keep your voice down! The audience can hear you! Remain quiet coming off stage until you are back in your change room.
