# Vibe Values

## INCLUSIVITY

Dance and cheer should be open to everyone, regardless of their age, gender, skill level, background or physical ability. The value of inclusivity ensures that every student feels welcome, accepted, and valued within the community. It celebrates and embraces differences and cultivates an environment where every student can thrive without discrimination or prejudice.

## JOY

Joy refers to a feeling of great pleasure and happiness. Dance is primarily an art form that is supposed to evoke emotions and feelings of delight and pleasure. Therefore, it is essential for students and instructors alike to embrace the value of joy in dance and cheer. Creating a joyous atmosphere motivates and inspires students and teachers to reach greater heights. Those who are encouraged to have fun as they train are more likely to develop a passion for their chosen activity and continue with it throughout their lifetime. The feeling of joy is contagious and spreads from one person to another. If everyone involved is having a good time, it makes it easier to work together and create memories that extend beyond the studio walls.

## KINDNESS

Kindness refers to the quality of being friendly, generous and considerate. When students, teachers, staff and family members display kindness towards one another in the studio, a positive atmosphere is created. This positive atmosphere encourages students to be more comfortable expressing themselves creatively. By taking risks and trying new things, students develop their confidence and resilience, which are attributes that can be applied far beyond dancing and cheerleading. It helps to create a positive and supportive community where students can thrive and grow both as dancers, cheerleaders and as individuals.

## SPORTSMANSHIP

Sportsmanship refers to the act of showing respect, fairness and generosity towards one's opponents, teammates, and officials in a competitive setting. Sportsmanship can include behaviours such as congratulating others on their successes, supporting those who are struggling, following the rules and guidelines of the studio and demonstrating an overall attitude of positivity and encouragement. When students display sportsmanship, they accept both their successes and their failures with grace and learn to see setbacks as opportunities for growth and progress.

## RESPECT

Respect is embodied in the way that the community interacts with one another, the instructors, the studio and the art form itself. There is a need for respect of the studio's facilities and equipment. Students and teachers should also demonstrate reliable behaviours such as arriving on time to class, dressing appropriately and treating each other with respect and attentiveness. These small yet meaningful gestures help to maintain a productive and positive learning environment for all students. Respect also means being open to feedback, adjusting behaviours and accepting constructive criticism. Parents play a vital role in promoting respect. They are a crucial part of the dance and cheer community and help to create a supportive and encouraging environment for the students. Parents are encouraged to model respect and set an example for their children when interacting with others in the studio.



# Facilities

---

Vibe Studios is located at 5-6/120 Canterbury Rd, Kilsyth South, VIC 3137 and includes:

- a large reception area with a drinks fridge and an ice-cream freezer,
- 4 large dance rooms fitted with full length mirrors and viewing windows,
- 1 small dance room fitted with full length mirrors,
- a 9-run sprung cheer floor,
- a 4-run sprung cheer floor,
- accessible toilets with a baby change table,
- change cubicles,
- lockers,
- a staff room, and
- split system heating and air conditioning in the reception area, staff room and Dance Room 1.



In 2015, after outgrowing three previous locations, we relocated to our current facility, transforming two factories into our expansive mega studio, which has since become a beloved second home for many. We feel incredibly fortunate to have a purpose-built space that meets our needs.

# Class Options

## ACRO

In this class, students work on their flexibility and learn acrobatic skills that can be incorporated into dance routines. Some of these skills include chin stands, cartwheels, walkovers, and aerials.

## ALL ABILITIES

We are very proud to offer dance classes to people with special abilities. At Vibe Studios, we believe that everyone deserves to love dance. Our All Ability lessons are very interactive. We work to enhance the gross and fine motor skills of all participants whilst having lots of fun at the same time.

## BALLET

Ballet is the foundation of dance and is the most technical class a dancer can participate in. We highly recommend ballet classes for those who wish to take their dance more seriously. In our ballet classes, students work on posture, breathing, balance, strength, flexibility, weight transference, and general ballet technique. The strength and control learned in these classes is an incredibly valuable asset to any dance style.

## BREAK

Break dancing, also referred to as b-boying/b-girling, is an athletic style of street dance. It is typically set to hip hop music and consists mainly of four kinds of movement: toprock (foot movement performed from a standing position), downrock (floor-based footwork), power moves (relying on speed, momentum, and acrobatic elements), and freezes (halting all body motion).

## BROADWAY JAZZ

Our Broadway jazz classes combine energetic dance with popular songs from beloved musicals like "Wicked," "Matilda," and "Aladdin." Students learn dynamic choreography while immersing themselves in the magic of Broadway dance!

## CECCHETTI BALLET

At Vibe Studios, we teach the internationally recognised Cecchetti ballet syllabus, which offers a structured approach to ballet training. This syllabus ensures a gradual development of sound technique while fostering a love for music and dance. It is suitable for all ages, from young beginners to pre-professional dancers, and includes specialised master classes, exclusive competitions, and a high standard of teacher training. Since its establishment in 1934, Cecchetti Ballet Australia has trained both teachers and students, with classes held in leading dance schools like the Victorian College of the Arts Secondary School and the Ministry of Dance. Students learn set exercises aimed at refining their ballet technique and have the opportunity to perform for Cecchetti examiners, receiving feedback and certificates for their accomplishments.

## CHEER

This is a fast-paced class that involves a lot of teamwork. The elements of cheerleading include stunting, tumbling, jumps, pyramids, and dance.

## CONTEMPORARY/LYRICAL

This style is one of our favorites! It can range from a strange angular style to soft graceful movements. It is a very free style that we try to change up for each class concert to concert.

## DANCE CONDITIONING

Introducing our brand-new dance conditioning classes in 2025, led by a qualified Cecchetti teacher! These classes focus on strengthening jazz and ballet techniques through targeted exercises, utilizing specialized equipment to enhance students' skills.

## HIP HOP

Hip hop is a street dance that is primarily performed to hip hop music. The commercialisation of hip hop means that it can now be seen in film clips by music artists such as Chris Brown and Jason Derulo. Though hip hop is established in entertainment, it maintains a strong presence in urban neighborhoods which has led to the creation of street dance derivatives like Baltimore, jerkin', krumping, and c-walking.

## JAZZ

Our jazz classes involve quick movements that match the fast-paced and popular songs that we love. In these classes, students work on technique, flexibility and performance. You can find things like high kicks, turns, shimmies and of course jazz hands!

## MUSICAL THEATRE

This is a very fun class that combines elements of singing, acting and dancing.

## POINTE

Pointe is traditional ballet. This class involves dancing in pointe shoes on the tips of fully extended feet. To take part in this class, dancers must have broad experience in ballet, and must also see and gain approval from a physio and a podiatrist.

## POM

Pom is a technical dance style that focuses heavily on strength to create striking visuals. Of course, these visuals are created with pom poms.

## SFD JAZZ

At Vibe Studios, we offer the Southern Federation of Dance syllabus in the style of jazz. In these classes, students are taught set exercises that are aimed at developing their jazz technique. Students who are ready have the option of performing these exercises in front of an SFD examiner who comes to Vibe Studios. They receive a report that is written up by the examiner with a mark, as well as a certificate and medal.

## SINGING

In the singing class, students will learn the fundamentals of singing techniques such as vocal warm-ups, breathing exercises, and proper posture. The class will focus on developing the student's vocal range, tone, pitch, and control to improve their overall singing abilities. This class is perfect for beginners or those who want to improve their singing skills and gain confidence in their voice.

## TAP

In these classes, students make sounds with their tap shoes by striking the floor as a form of percussion. One of the benefits of participating in tap classes is learning to understand timing and rhythm. This is of benefit to all other styles of dance.

## TUMBLING

In this class, students work on their tumbling skills that are required for cheerleading and useful for dance. Some of these skills include cartwheels, walkovers, handsprings, tucks and layouts.

# In Class Uniform

In our recreational classes, there is no specific uniform requirement aside from our exam classes. We do offer Vibe active wear for purchase at reception for students who wish to represent Vibe. Otherwise, students are welcome to wear comfortable clothing from home that allows for movement. For classes such as ballet, jazz, and contemporary/lyrical, we strongly recommend tight-fitting attire. Wearing the right active wear is crucial for several reasons: it enables students to move freely and comfortably, fosters a sense of unity and belonging, and allows instructors to more effectively assess and correct technique. Specific footwear is required for most recreational classes, and it is essential for both practice and performances. Please note that school uniforms, dresses and jeans are not acceptable attire for classes.

## CECCHETTI BALLET & SFD JAZZ UNIFORM

We are very excited to be introducing new colours and designs to our Cecchetti Ballet and SFD Jazz uniform for 2025. Previously, we had to adhere strictly to the Cecchetti Society's regulations since all our Cecchetti exams were held at Ministry of Dance. However, with our Grades 1-6 exams now taking place in our very own studio, we have greater freedom when it comes to our uniform choices. Students are now free to wear whichever style of Energetiks leotard they like to class, in their designated colour. This will allow our students to express their own creativity and individuality while still maintaining a cohesive look. However, please note that for those who do take their Cecchetti Ballet and SFD Jazz exams, uniformity is still required, so we have set a specific leotard style for exams only. It is also critical to emphasise that excluding black, the colours we provide are specific to Energetiks. Students must wear the exact colours from Energetiks and cannot wear leotards or skirts from any other brand.

# Extra Opportunities

---

## **CHOREOGRAPHY COMPETITION**

Held in March, our annual Choreography Competition gives all students at Vibe Studios the opportunity to create and perform their own routine. Students can enter as a soloist or with peers as a duo/trio. We have a supportive audience of friends, family and peers along with a guest judge who is not involved with Vibe to come in and critique the choreography fairly. We have extra competitions throughout the day for jazz, lyrical and hip hop improvisation. Every participant receives a certificate and there are also many ribbons, medals, trophies and vouchers to be won.

## **DANCESTEP**

DanceStep is a worldwide student teacher education program designed by Dance Studio Success founder Jane Grech. Each level requires 20 practical hours of assistant teaching and is generally one year in duration. There is also an online learning portal tailored to the learning needs and ages of students. Whether considering a career in dance teaching or otherwise, DanceStep is a great preparation for many aspects of life. At our studio, students can apply to be a part of this program in the year they turn 13 by contacting us at reception and filling out an application form.

## **INDUSTRY PROFESSIONAL SESSIONS**

In the past, we have had the pleasure of hosting industry professionals like Dr. Lisa from Dance Prescription, who brought invaluable insights and expertise to our studio. Looking ahead to 2025, we are ramping up our commitment to excellence by inviting a dynamic lineup of industry professionals, including sports physiotherapists and guest choreographers, to join us. These exciting sessions will be a fantastic opportunity for our students to broaden their skills and expand their artistic repertoire.

## **PRIVATE LESSONS**

Any student at Vibe can book a private lesson with one of our teachers to help catch them up or excel further. These lessons can involve working on technique, skills or choreography/exam exercises. Private lessons cost \$1.30 per minute for one student and can be booked in any style as a once off or on a permanent basis. Private lessons can also be shared between 2-3 students. Please see our fee schedule for further information on these costs.

## **TROUPE**

For those looking to elevate their dance and cheer experience, we offer an exciting avenue through our competitive troupe classes. This opportunity is perfect for those who aspire to take their skills to the next level, as our competitive teams train at a higher level and participate in 4 competitions each year, in addition to our bi-annual show-offs and concerts.
